MBX Meeting Etiquette

In order to insure a consistent and predictable referral culture, MBX observes the following guidelines. These rules are created for the protection and success of our chapter members.

- 1. Meetings start at 7:00 AM sharp. The first 15 minutes of the hour are active networking minutes. Member are intended to stand for the full 15-minutes in order to meet guests, visit with fellow chapter members and exchange referrals.
- 2. Cell phones should be set to silence or stun. Answering your cell phone, texting, and other mediafocused activities are unfair to those who are presenting their 30-second infomercial or otherwise talking.
- 3. MBX members should always stand when speaking. Sitting takes energy and attention away from speaking.
- 4. Guests should be openly welcomed. Share information about yourself and invite the guest to join the group.
- 5. Attendance is mandatory. Repeated absence is strongly disapproved. An MBX member may miss up to three times before her/his category is opened.
- 6. Members must represent their primary occupation during the MBX hour, not a hobby, second career, or personal interest.
- 7. Speakers must bring a door prize on the day of their 5-minute presentation. The door prize is awarded to someone who made a business referral on the day of the presentation.
- 8. Members who wish to change their membership category must fill out a new application and submit it to the membership committee. Subject to the membership committee's ruling, the member MAY be allowed to change category.
- 9. In the event of a problem with a member, a complaint may be filed with the membership committee for evaluation.
